

NATURAL PROGRAM PRODUCT GUIDE – CATTLE

Allowed Health Products and Protocols

- **All vaccines**
 - Examples: IBR/BRSV/BVD/PI3, Lepto, Mannheimia Haemolytica (Pasteurella), Haemophilus Somnus, Clostridials/Blackleg, Mycoplasma, Pinkeye, etc.
- **Dewormers and Parasite Control**
 - Examples: Ivomec, Safeguard, Warbex, etc
- ***Coccidiostats as treatment or if prior cocci problem and as prescribed by a Veterinarian**
 - Examples: Amprolium, Calf Guard, Corid, Deccox
- **Non-Steroid anti-inflammatories**
 - Example: Banamine
- **Pyrethrene & Abamectin based fly tags**
 - Cyence Ultra, Gardstar Plus, Python, XP 820, etc

- **All grain, grass, and legume type products**
- **Minerals and Vitamins**
 - Must **not** contain antibiotics or animal by-products
 - CAN contain IGR fly control mineral additives
 - Clarifly (Diflubenzuron), Altosid, etc.
- **Natural Protein Supplements & Urea**
- **Glycerin that is VEGETABLE based**
- **Probiotics/Yeasts/Enzymes/Rumen Buffers/Certain other additives**
 - Examples: Bovamine, MicroCell Gold, Oregain, Rumathec, Bio-Mos, Fastrack, Corid, Deccox, CinnaGar, etc
- **Non-Organophosphate based fly controls**

Recommended Management Protocols:

- Records verifying birthdates on calves (individual birthdates or first and last born date of calving season)
- All calves individually identified with ear tag and EID tag
- Polled genetics preferred – dehorning restrictions in some programs
- Records verifying vaccination protocol and dates and weaning dates
- Records of cattle treated
- Castrate bull calves at 90 days of age or younger
- Wean all calves at 6 months of age or older

Products listed above are common examples. This list does not represent an all-inclusive list of allowable products. Producers should contact their Veterinarian, Nutrition/Supplement Supplier, Marketing Agent, or Natural Auditor for verification of other products.

Non-Allowable Health Products and Protocols

This list is to be used as a guideline only. There may be other requirements or products that are not allowed. Do NOT use:

- **Growth Promoting Hormones/Steroids/Implants**
 - Examples: Revalor, Ralgro, Synovex, Compudose, Encore, Component, Dexamethasone, etc.
 - Beta-agonists (example: Optiflexx)
- **Estrus Suppressants**
 - Examples: Lutalyse, Estrumate, etc.
- **Antibiotics - Oral or Injectable or as Fed in Supplements**
 - Examples: Draxxin, Micotil, Resflor, AS700, Excede, Naxcel, Spectinomycin, Auremycin, Excenel, Neomycin, Sulfas (Albon, Sustain), Baytril, Callimycin, Nuflor, Tetradure, Biomycin, Gentocin, Oxytetracycline, Chloretetracycline, Tylan, LA200, Penicillin, Hexasol, etc.
 - Examples: CTC, Auromycin, etc.
- **Organophosphate based fly tags**
 - Corathon, Patriot, Warrior, Optimizer, etc.

- **Ionophores**
 - Examples: Bovatec, Cattylist, Gain-Pro, Rumensin, V-Max, Monensin, etc
- **Animal By-Products in Feedstuffs/Ingredients**
 - Feather Meal, Fish Oil, Poultry Litter, Milk Replacers, Whey, Tallow, Yellow Grease, Animal-based or blend Glycerin
 - Any by-product from birds, fish, or mammals including cattle, swine, sheep, goats, or poultry.
- **Organophosphates**
 - Example: Rabon, etc.

Products listed above are common examples. This list does not represent an all-inclusive list of non-allowable or prohibited products. Producers should contact their Veterinarian, Nutrition/Supplement Supplier, Marketing Agent, or Natural Auditor for verification of other products and practices.
